08/31	In keeping with the established culture of Capilano University, that the definition of faculty member (see Appendix 1) as it appears in the University Act (R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 468, consolidated by the Office of the University Counsel of UBC as of 30 September 2008) be extended to include lab supervisors, private music instructors, instructional associates, special positions and appointees, counsellors, and librarians. 08/32	That lab supervisors, private music instructors, instructional associates, special positions and appointees, counsellors, and librarians should be associated with faculties as illustrated in the proposed structure for the Senate (see Appendix 2).	December 2
08/33	To complement the Senate structure proposed in Appendix 2 non-voting members will be elected from the larger faculties, in addition to the two required voting members, so as to provide these faculties a more representative voice on the Senate. The total number of non-voting members and their distribution amongst the larger faculties will be determined according to the method described in Appendix 3. Note that the additional non-voting members would become voting members in the absence of voting members.	December 2
08/34	At the two year anniversary of the new Senate, a formal evaluation procedure will be initiated and any appropriate recommendations will be forwarded to the Board in time to facilitate any changes that will have an impact on the electoral process.	December 2
