Junior All Native Tournament

Between March 19-23, Capilano University hosted the province's largest youth basketball tournament of the year: the Junior All Native Tournament. More than 800 Aboriginal youth from 82 communities across BC participated. Over 3500 parents, family and friends came to CapU's campus to watch, and Melanie Mark, Minister of Advance Education, Skills and Training, and Toran Savjord participated in the opening ceremonies.

Blues Annual Athletic Banquet

Held on April 4 at the Seymour Golf and Country Club, this year's banquet marked its 24th anniversary and celebrated the achievements of CapU's student-athletes. CapU has 96 Blues student-athletes enrolled in 17 programs, and 48% have a GPA of 3.0 or better. Of the 96 Blues student-athletes, 20 are Canadian Collegiate Athletic

Association (CCAA) National Scholars and 14 are Pacific Western Athletic Association (PACWEST) Academic Excellence Award Winners. Congratulations to all of our student-athletes, who champion hard work and team work both in the classroom and in sports.
