Voting Members: Dean, the Chair or Coordinator of each School and, where the Chair oversees more than one School, a program convener from those respective Schools as determined by DAC (total 6 members).

Reports to: DAC and Full Faculty¹

- Curriculum discussion and approvals brought forward from respective School curriculum committees. Approvals are reported to DAC.
- Holds up to two Academic Planning forums with faculty annually prior to, or in combination with, the Full Faculty meeting and prepares an academic plan framework. This framework will be based on academic goals of the Faculty which will be discussed annually and are derived principally from the Faculty Agreement in Principle (May 24th 2012). The framework will be presented to DAC for approval.
- Receives, considers, and makes recommendations to DAC on feedback from Industry Advisory Committees through School Chairs and/or Coordinators
- Receives, Assesses and makes recommendations to DAC on Student Learning Outcome Program Assessment Reports
- Broadly monitors implementation of a Faculty Academic Framework and provides related recommendations to DAC
- Engages when appropriate and necessary with other APC's to contribute toward university wide academic planning
