How to become a CapU Student

1. Apply for your program of choice

Apply through the Education Planner BC portal AND pay the international student fee of \$135 CAD.
capilano.ca/apply

2. Receive your Letter of Offer

Secure your admission by paying the \$5,000 CAD tuition deposit by the deadline stated in your letter.

3. Receive your Acceptance Letter and Provincial Attestation Letter

Apply for or renew a study permit (and an entry visa, depending on citizenship).

4. Register for courses

Register online and pay your tuition fees.

5. Track your application
