In the Bachelor of Arts with a Major in Writing and Literature degree at CapU, you'll combine your shared loves of writing, research and literature to create a skillset to fit a variety of exciting creative careers.

CHOOSE FROM TWO CONCENTRATIONS

In your degree, you can choose from two concentrations: Critical and Creative Writing or Literature and Culture.

On the writing side, you'll take engaging seminar courses on topics including children's literature, poetry and screenwriting. The literature and culture concentration focuses on research and cultural studies in courses ranging from Victorian novels, to literature in media or film, to global literature, to Indigenous narratives.

GET PUBLISHING AND TEACHING EXPERIENCE BEFORE GRADUATING

In your final years, you can work on the editorial team on CapU's student literary journal, *The Liar*. You'll choose poetry and prose for publication, run publicity campaigns and manage layout and launch of the magazine.
