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- **Residency Requirement:**
 - Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
 - Students in this program that have transferred to Capilano University with 50 or more credits from another institution that are residing outside of the Vancouver area and are unable to take courses in-person at Capilano University have a residency requirement of 25%.
- **Graduation Requirement:** A *minimum CGPA of 2.00* (calculated on all program required courses) must be achieved to graduate from all Capilano University credentials. Programs may have additional graduation requirements as approved by the University Senate.

- **Cap Core Requirement:** Students starting in their baccalaureate degree on or after Fall 2018 and graduating on or after June 2022 must meet Cap Core graduation requirements in addition to their program requirements.
